Women Leadership Program

A. Scholarship:

Sisterhood supports girls who want to go to college, but need financial support. Sisterhood Scholars come from different fields; they are graduate students from commerce, math, nursing, engineering, science streams. As on 31st of December 70 students are part of Sisterhood Scholarship Project.

Highlights

- a. This year we selected 18 students from Rural village near Chennai, and 34 students from Chennai.
- **b.** We have referred 18 sisterhood students for GNGA scholarship, which offers higher financial support. 52 received financial support from Sisterhood.
- c. This year 27 students passed this year. 164 students passed from Sisterhood Scholarship Program since its inception.
- d. Amount spent on scholarship: 1. 72 Lakhs in 2023 (jan-dec)





Monthly Training:

Every month on the first Sunday of the week, we conduct a monthly training program for scholars. Last year, 8 classes and 2 volunteer opportunities were provided to the scholars. Classes on various topics like Leadership, Finance, Employability, Politics, and Volunteering, Budgeting, Entrepreneurship, Relationship skills and group discussions were conducted for them in a one-day class

Sisterhood Foundation was involved in the next selection of new scholars in the month of July. We received approximately 160 applicants and shortlisted 45 and selected 30 candidates.




August-Welcoming the new scholars

During the month of Joy of Giving, our students split up and went to two different orphanages: Anbagam Trust and Turning Point Educational Trust, to distribute items and organise events. Whereas 32 students went to Anbagam Trust organized fun activities for the elderly, 12 students went to Turning Point Educational Trust held competitions for children, such as sketching and games, and handed gifts to the children.

We extended our scholarship program to rural girls in Viruthachalam. We received 103 applications, and selected 19 students. We conducted classes once in two months.

September month

On September 15, 2023, IGiver handed safe-pads to Sisterhood Foundation. The trainer Mrs.Meena trained our students about the menstrual hygiene and reproductive health. Over 20 students attended the class, 17 students received safe pads and awareness was raised about personal menstrual hygiene.
